**Tropical Storm Warning issued for Barnegat
Barnegat Township fully prepared and ready for
Hurricane Earl**

The Township of Barnegat is fully prepared and ready for any contingency resulting from Hurricane Earl. Over the past several days, Barnegat's Emergency Management team has been monitoring the status of the storm. In addition, Township storm preparation meetings have been conducted to ready Barnegat for forecasted tropical storm conditions on Friday, September 3, 2010.

At this time, weather conditions similar to that of a winter time coastal storm are anticipated on Friday. Township personnel will be ready to respond to any storm related need. Report any hazardous conditions to the Barnegat Township Police Department at (609) 698-5000. Only call 911 if it is a medical emergency or other urgent situation that requires an immediate response from the police.

Again, the Township is fully prepared and ready for the storm. Township personnel will be ready to respond to any storm related need for assistance.
