

Upon Arrival, you will receive tickets which provide admission to the Grounds and Specialty Gardens, Train Show, Rock & Native Plant Gardens, Public Tram (weather permitting), and the Enid A. Haupt Conservatory. (Specialty Gardens are seasonal)

The Holiday Train show exhibit which has more than 100 replicas of historic New York buildings, all made from plant parts and other natural materials, are the highlight of the Garden's 13th annual Holiday Train Show. Creator Paul Busse of Applied Imagination has transformed leaves, twigs, berries, pinecones, and other botanical materials into dazzling reproductions of landmarks like the Statue of Liberty, the Metropolitan Museum of Art, and the Garden's own Enid A. Haupt Conservatory. Railway trains and trolleys add another magical touch as they wind their way through this miniature world, disappearing into forest tunnels to reappear with a surprising flourish.
