

Resolution 2018 - 80

AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF BARNEGAT TO RETAIN THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES OF THE GOLDSTEIN PARTNERSHIP TO PERFORM A FEASIBILITY STUDY IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW MUNICIPAL BUILDING

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5 the Township of Barnegat desires to retain The Goldstein Partnership to conduct a feasibility study at a cost not to exceed \$29,500.00 which will include architectural and technology consulting services in connection with the construction of a new Municipal/Police/Court building; and,

WHEREAS, as part of their services, The Goldstein Group will assess the short term and long term needs of the Township as they relate to the municipal, police, and court functions; and,

WHEREAS, The Goldstein Partnership will develop site designs, site concepts, will develop a construction schedule, and will develop budget plans for the construction of the new municipal building; and

WHEREAS, The Goldstein Partnership has submitted a proposal dated January 24, 2018 to the Township Administrator which sets forth the duties it shall be required to perform in greater detail; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Barnegat Township Mayor and Township Committee are hereby authorized to execute a contract for professional services with The Goldstein Partnership; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Township officials including, but not limited to the Mayor, the Township Administrator and the Municipal Clerk, are hereby authorized and directed to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the provisions of this resolution.
